1. SNAP Plan – signatures required

Walking/Bussing routes reviewed. New map has been created. Discussed intersection on the south east corner of the the school should be considered to be a 3-way stop. Add a left turn line for exiting the drop-off. Paint curbs red near entrance/exit and crosswalks to restrict parking. Signed and approved SNAP plan.

- 2. Willow Springs Safety Plan
 Discussed school evacuation plan and routes.
- 3. Cell Tower Money \$5,854.84, move \$1000 to assemblies?
 Request for approval to move to assemblies. Scales and tails assembly, and book assembly proposed. Motion voted on and approved by the council.
 - 4. Attendance Data -50% of dropouts can be identified by attendance and grades. District has a goal of 80% of students with 90% attendance. (That's still two absences a month or 18 absences)
 - a. On Track = absences are less than 10%
 - b. At Risk = absences are 10%-19.9%
 - c. Off Track = absences are 20% or more

Discussed incentives to bring up attendance. 85 Children are at-risk of not making the 90% goal and% 19 are below (80% or lower)

5. New District Attendance Policy – Excused absences-specific definition. Guardian excused absences will be limited to 5 per year. Vacation/Education Leave is still 10 days per year.
