The school is still performing above the state average. School has been focusing more on reading proficiency. Reviewed our CISP goals for the year. Our district was not meeting the goal overall. If goals were not met a loss of funding would be possible. We are on track to meet the goals and continue to focus on meeting the District goals. Discussed the path forward to achieve the goals. Reviewed student advancement reports focusing on those that moved from basic or below basic to higher levels from Fall to Winter.
