1) Complete CSIP (Continuous School Improvement Plan)/Land Trust

We have a continued focus on reading to keep our upward trend with student progress. Changed our reading interventionists that work with below benchmark students. Added 5 aides to enhance the program. Reviewed Academic Goals. We feel 80% of students should advance and currently we are at 31%. Modified the goal to 50% of 4th and 5th grade students advance from basic to proficient or advanced in RI (Reading Inventory). Spent some time talking about this goal how it's measured and the work going into achieving this goal. Reviewed our Action Plan. Professional Development on explicit vocabulary instruction and close reading protocol. Leveraging technology through Reading Plus. Additionally coaching cycles with the teachers to improve student instruction. Reviewed current expenditures of the school. Updated wording of some of the goals. Council signed the Land Trust Goals. Plan was approved.
