Subject: TSSP Amendment Request

Willow Springs Elementary School would like to amend their 2021-22 TSSP in order to better serve the needs of their students.

Reason for the proposed amendment:

We have seen an increase in externalizing behaviors due to the covid pandemic. Fall Student Risk Screening Scale (SRSS-IE) data shows that 84% of our students fell within the Low Risk range for Externalizing behaviors. Winter SRSS-IE data shows the percentage of students in the Low Risk range for Externalizing behaviors has dropped to 78%. We feel that mindfulness tools would offer opportunities to develop sensory and emotional regulation skills in a safe environment – the classroom. In order to increase the availability of mindfulness tools over all grades, we would like to purchase Calming Kits for every classroom and specialists classrooms in the school.

Original Goal:

By spring of 2022, Willow Springs teachers will have given an average of 5 PRIDE Paw tickets per month as measured by a monthly tally.

Original Allocated Expenditures: \$0

Proposed TSSP Goal Change:

By Spring of 2022, 80% of students (K-5) will be in the Low Risk range of externalizing behaviors as measured by the Student Risk Screening Scale (SRSS-IE).
